1. Requirements:

- The candidate should be a resident of Meghalaya.
- Age limit: Minimum of 18 years or above.

2. Selection Process:

- Apart from filled Application Form, Resume & Certificates, a “Cover Letter” stating your interest & willingness to take up this “Apprenticeship Training Program” is a must.
- Selection based on merit as per mark secured in the degree/ diploma course as mentioned against each - Apprentice posts would be one part of the selection process.
- Personal Interview.
